Last years intensive research has been started on climate change impacts in Hungary under the umbrella of Programme for Adaptation to Climate Change funded by the Grants of European Economic Area. Important objective of the Programme is to establish partnerships with the donor countries (especially Norway) and countries in the Central and Eastern European (CEE) region. The workshop is dedicated to introduce the ongoing and planned researches on climate change and adaptation, to share experiences on this area and climate-related communication, to discuss the cooperation possibilities with the participants from CEE, Norway and other part of the continent.
